

SCHEDULE OF CLASSES

VEGETABLES
1: Onions – red or white 2 matching, roots washed and neck of 7.5cm left on
2: Shallots – 3 matching, roots washed and neck of 7.5cm left on
3: Potatoes – 3 matching, any variety, washed
4: Cherry Tomatoes – 5 on stalk
5: Tomatoes – large 3 matching with calyx attached
6: Sweetcorn – 1 half stripped so that kernels can be seen
7: Carrot – 2 matching washed, with tap root intact and leaves trimmed to 7.5cm
8: Beetroot - 2 matching washed, with tap root intact and leaves trimmed to 7.5cm
9: Leek – 1 with roots washed
10: Courgette – 2 matching
11: Squash – Any single squash with 7.5cm of stalk attached
12: Runner Beans – 3 matching

13: French Beans – 5 matching
14: Cabbage – trimmed
15: Any other vegetable
16: Largest vegetable – by weight
17: Ugliest vegetable
FRUIT
18: Pear – 3 matching
19: Apples, Desert – 3 not polished
20: Apples, Cooking – 3 not polished
21: Raspberries – 7 with calyx attached
22: Blackberries – 7 with calyx attached
23: Any other fruit

FLOWERS
24: Vase of your Garden Flowers – In a suitable vase of your choice
25: Dahlias – 3 blooms of any variety or mixed
26: Chrysanthemums – 3 matching any variety
27: Roses – 3 blooms any variety
28: Herbs – bunch in water
29: House plant – Flower or foliage must have belonged to the exhibitor for at least 12 months
JUNIOR
30: INFANT 5-7 Collage – Using any part of fruit/veg/flower create a collage of ‘ An Insect ’ A4 size
31: JUNIOR 8-11 Collage – Using any part of fruit/veg/flower create a collage of ‘ An Insect ’ A4 size
32: INFANT 5-7 Model – Using any part of fruit/veg/flower create a 3D model of ‘ A Creature ’ with a name
33: JUNIOR 8-11 Model – Using any part of fruit/veg/flower create a 3D model of ‘ A Creature ’ with a name

PRODUCE
34: A jar of Jam – made with fresh fruit
35: A jar of Chutney or Piccalilli
36: A White Loaf – made with 500g of flour (Please, no bread makers)
37: Victoria sponge – Made with 3 eggs and a filling of your choice
38: Plain scones – 3 scones
39: Biscuits – 3 biscuits of any type
40: Fruit loaf – any type of fruit loaf
41: Eggs – 3 eggs
